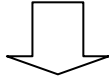
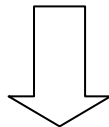


HOW TO..... GET CONTINENCE PADS!!!!

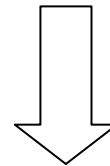
Self Referral to Blue Care
(Currently 3 – 4 week wait list)



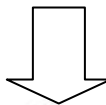
Blue Care will contact GP for necessary information including medical history and medication list (See GP Referral)



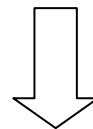
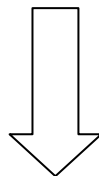
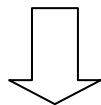
GP referral to Blue Care requesting application for continence aids.
Referral to contain: **current list of medications; medical and surgical history; list of any urological investigations and outcomes; and any other information deemed relevant**
(Currently 3 – 4 week wait list)



Admission of client to Blue Care Service, commencement of full Continence Assessment, education on continence issues, techniques to improve current incontinence and a variety of sample containment aids explained and left with client to trial so the best option is ordered through DVA, MASS, and/or CAAS



Follow up visit 1 – 2 weeks later
Continence Assessment completed.
DVA, MASS &/or CAAS applications attended to and sent



Medical Aids Subsidy Scheme (MASS)

Must be Concession/Seniors Card holder
Extensive range available with subsidy limits on more expensive items
Delivery can take 3 – 4 months from time of application
6 months supply is delivered each time.
No exchange of products or extra supplies given within 6 month period
Client to purchase own aids in interim

DVA RAP

Must have Gold Card
Broad Product Range
Delivery is prompt

Continence Aids Assistance Scheme (CAAS)

Available to 5 yrs and older with Neurological condition – Concession card not required
Specified non-neurological conditions – Concession card required
Receive current subsidy funding of \$479.40 per year on continence products ordered through “Intouch Products and Services”
Phone orders are self managed
Direct to door delivery within 3 days of order
Funding renews every 1 July
